Exhibitors **must purchase an early entry wrist band (@£9)** when submitting their entry form in order to enter the show hall to book in their birds, which allows early entry to the Sales Day once your birds are checked in. **An SAE is required** with your entries to return your wrist band and cage labels.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Saturday 28th September 2019

Cages will be displayed sideways so cage labels should be attached on the bottom right hand corner on the long side with the drinker to the right as you look at it. Black 'D' drinkers are required. Tubular drinkers may be used in addition but will be removed during judging.

Birds accepted Saturday 5th October from 5-7pm

& Sunday 6th October 7.30-9am.

The prime aim of this show is the exhibition of quality Yorkshire Canaries. There are no sales classes as such. No more than 20% of your entries can be offered for sale in the main classes. The price of such birds should be clearly stated on your entry form. The Y.C.C. will deduct 10% of the sales price as its commission. Those not for sale should be marked N.F.S. (not for sale) on the entry form.

Judging and allocation of awards should be completed by about 1pm when the show will be open to the public. The best seven champion and novice exhibits will receive special diplomas. There will be additional awards in the Yorkshire section as follows:

- Best Yorkshire*
 - Best Champion Yorkshire
 - Best Novice Yorkshire
 - Best Junior Yorkshire*
 - Best White Yorkshire*
- Exhibits marked * also compete for:
Best Canary & Best Junior & Best White
Canary in Show.

Exhibits cannot be lifted until the official close of the exhibition which will be announced in the hall at around 3.30pm.
